

The third Monday in January is officially Martin Luther King, Jr. Day in the United States. This day is to remember the life of Dr. King and celebrate the values and ideals he championed.






Match the questions in column one with the appropriate answer in column two:


- a. Who was MLK's inspiration for nonviolence?

- f. Did Dr. King ever have any problems with authorities?


- 1. He was assassinated by a white supremacist by the name of James Earl Ray on April 4, 1968, on the balcony of his room in a motel near the center of Memphis.
- 2. Before and during his time as a civil rights activist, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. was a Baptist preacher at a small church in Montgomery, Alabama.
- 3. Martin Luther King Jr. stated several times as a civil rights activist that many of his techniques for protest were derived from his idol, Mahatma Gandhi.
- 4. During his time as a pastor and activist, Martin Luther King Jr. was arrested a total of 20 times and was reportedly beaten at least four of those times.
- 5. Martin Luther King Jr. received the Nobel Peace Prize in 1964.
- 6. Martin Luther King Jr. graduated from high school at the age of 15 and was class valedictorian.
