


Final Round

Guidelines:

- The final takes place on Thursday September 24
 - The math part will take place at your school starting at 8:30. No special preparation necessary.
 - The geography part will consist of two stages. In Stage 1 you will make an electronic presentation (due on Monday September 21), in Stage 2 you will personally give your presentation. This part starts at 10:30.
 - Additional information for geography follows:
1. Electronic presentation:
 - Describe your topic. Focus on specific, unique, and attractive information.
 - The electronic presentation is supposed to be concise with clear and well-structured points. Follow the basic rules for creating presentations.
 - Include text, pictures, optionally graphs, maps, tables, etc.
 - Produce a presentation of 10–15 slides.
 - The last slide will include a group photo of all the team members (don't include the names).

2. Oral presentation and defence:
 - You will give your presentations at the final event on Thursday September 24.
 - You will be using a PC with a functional camera and microphone, connected to the internet.
 - The presentations will be given through MS Teams. The link will be provided by the organizers.
 - You will present your work (the electronic presentation with comments) to the other teams and the committee live online.
 - During the presentation you will show the electronic presentation, and you will accompany it by your comments live online.
 - The presentation will be given by **at least two team members**.
 - The presentations will be 8–10 minutes long.

Focus mainly on:

- ethnic structure,
- religious structure,
- age structure,
- towns & cities

3. Economy of our country

Focus mainly on:

- mining,
- production of energy,
- agriculture,
- industry.

4. Cultural heritage of our country

Focus mainly on:

- UNESCO World Heritage Sites,
- castles,
- museums.

5. Natural landmarks in our country

Focus mainly on:

- areas of environmental protection
- fauna & flora,
- mountains and mountain ranges,
- caves and cave systems.

6. Customs and traditions in our country

Focus mainly on:

- Advent and Christmas,
- Lent and Easter,
- weddings,
- folk costumes.
